Under this agreement for 2020 Stanwell State School will receive

\$18, 266*

This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% of students meet NAPLAN national minimum standards in all strands in Years 3 and Year 5.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving above a 'C' standard or above in English, Maths & Science to above 80% in Prep – Year 6.
- Build teacher capacity in data analysis and interpretation, to strengthen differentiation and feedback to improve student outcomes.
- Implement Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) to improve student and staff wellbeing.
- Implement an early years program to support early literacy & numeracy skills.

Our initiatives include

- Building teacher capability in reviewing student data to determine differentiation and to develop *Specific Targeted Teaching Strategies (STTS)* and successfully implement achievable *Student Individual Learning Goals (SILG)*; with use of the *P-10 Literacy Continuum*. (*Putting Faces on the Data: Lyn Sharrat*)
- Providing time for professional development & peer coaching as a school-wide pedagogical approach to ensure staff embed signature pedagogies and provide targeted and scaffolded instruction for students' learning in numeracy and literacy, incorporating the BIG 6 (Konza), high-yield teaching strategies (*CQ Model- Fleming, Hattie & Marzano*)
- Upskilling staff in using OneSchool for assessment data, behaviour records and support plans.
- Participate in in cluster moderation and cluster networking opportunities to network & build capacity
- Providing support for parents and students in the early years to support the development of literacy and numeracy skills at home and continue the *Step into Prep Program*.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Providing TRS to enable teachers to engage in collaborative work to build capabilities in the Australian Curriculum, unit planning, moderation and PBL by internal and external providers.	\$10 000
• Implementing PBL practices throughout the whole school setting.	\$ 4 266
• Employing support staff to assist students in literacy and numeracy and to implement early years programs	\$ 4 000
